## What We Are Learning

Religion: Next week we will be learning more about the Eucharist and what it means to us as Catholics. We will also be looking at the different parts of Mass and how they came to be.

**Reading/Writing**: Next week students have their first key assignment due for Experts' Fair. Each student must write 15-20 questions directly about their topic. These questions are due on **1/30**.
